Greetings to you!

The syllabus drafting committee of our college framed the revised regulations for the B.Ed. programme (with effect from 2018 - 2020 batch), followed by the approval of Board of Studies on 27.03.2018 and Academic Council on 05.04.2018. The Governing Body meeting was conducted on 03-05-2018 to discuss and assess the various issues related to the development of the institution. The Finance Committee meeting was conducted on 17.04.2018. The IQAC meeting was held on 26.03.2018 to enhance the quality of Education.

Out of 22 B.Ed. students who appeared for the third semester examination, 17 students secured first class with distinction, 4 students secured first class and one student passed with second class, securing 100 percent pass rate. Our 3 M.Ed. students who appeared for the third semester examination, 2 students passed with first class with distinction and one student secured first class, securing 100 percent pass rate. Out of 71 B.Ed. students who appeared for the first semester examination, 17 students secured first class with distinction and 54 students secured first class, securing 100 percent pass rate.

First and Second Year B.Ed. **Practical Examination** was held on 16-03-2018, under the convenorship of Dr. (Mrs.) Joseph Catherine, Principal, Stella Matutina College of Education, Ashok Nagar, Chennai-83. 23 Second year B.Ed. Students and 69 First year B.Ed. Students appeared for the Practical Examinations.

Mock Viva-Voce was conducted for M.Ed. second year students on 26-03-2018 to provide prior experience to face the main examination with confidence. **M.Ed. Viva-Voce Examination** for second year students was conducted on 27-03-2018.

The **Model Examinations** for B.Ed. and M.Ed. (both Second and Fourth Semesters) were held from 19th to 26th April, 2018. The **Second and Fourth Semester Examinations** for B.Ed. and M.Ed. were held from 4th to 11th May, 2018.
