Greetings to you!

We thank and adore the Heavenly Father for his goodness and grace towards all the bustles of our institution during the second episode of the academic year 2018 – 2019. The Finance Committee meeting was conducted on 15.04.2019. The IQAC meeting was held on 27.04.2019 to enhance the quality of education. The Governing Body meeting was conducted on 07.05.2019 to discuss and assess the various issues related to the development of the institution.

Out of 69 B.Ed. students (2017-2019 batch) who appeared for the third semester examinations, 14 students secured first class with distinction, 43 students secured first class and 12 students passed with second class, securing 100 percent pass rate. Ms. S. Girija bagged the top spot.

Out of 89 B.Ed. students (2018-2020 batch) who appeared for the first semester examinations, 10 students secured first class with distinction, 72 students secured first class and 4 students passed with second class, securing 97 percent pass rate. Ms. Betsy Francis bagged the top honour.

Out of 2 M.Phil. students (2018-2019 batch) who appeared for the first semester examinations, one student secured with first class with distinction and the other secured first class, securing 100 percent pass rate. Mr. G. Charles Antonyraj bagged the top place.

First and Second Year B.Ed. Practical Examination was held on 15th March, 2018, under the convenorship of Dr. (Mrs.) Kapila Shobini, Associate Professor of English, Institute of Advanced Study in Education, Saidapet, Chennai -15. 89 first year B.Ed. students and 68 second year B.Ed. students appeared for the practical examinations.

Mock Viva-Voce was conducted for M.Phil. students on 15th April, 2019 to provide prior experience to face the main examination with confidence, followed by Viva - Voce on 16th April, 2019. The Model Examinations for both Second and Fourth Semesters for B.Ed. and M.Phil. were held from 24th April to 2nd May, 2019. The Second and Fourth Semester Examinations for B.Ed. and M.Phil. were held from 14th to 21st May, 2019.

Our College organized a two day National Seminar on 30th and 31st January, 2019 on "Instructional Efficiency to Prepare the Post - Millennials for 2025". Sivakumar, Professor & Head, Department of Education (DDE), Alagappa University, Karaikudi on "Building Bridges between Existing and Future Educational Assessment". For the grand finale of the National Seminar, Prof. R. Thandavan, Former Vice-Chancellor, University of Madras, Chennai delivered the valedictory address.

Sixteen colleges of Education participated including 81 students and 11 staff members to make this workshop a memorable one. 




