The Vice-President and Dean of our College Dr.N.Vijayan insisted need based curriculum in the practical components, mentioning the problem, solution and guidance to tackle them.

Rev.Fr.Lourdusamy Susai Secretary of our College suggested that the autonomous institutions should look beyond and broader in terms of Quality in Education.

Dr.Sunita Sanwal, UGC nominee, NCERT, New Delhi suggested to be in touch with the students. She also suggested to move on to Competence Based Taxonomy rather than sticking to Bloom's Taxonomy. She informed to go through NCERT guideline to know about the Learning outcomes and how the expectations change among the next generation learners. To improve the learning outcomes, teacher training should cater to the needs of the students. It should be an integral part of the curriculum, giving weightage for emotional health & physical health.

Dr.Paul Devanesan suggested to start 'Curriculum Development Cell' in order to bring our institution to International Level. He also suggested to raise 'Income sources through Projects' by taking social related issues and form a Research Committee in our College.

Dr.Ravanan, Regional Joint Director of Collegiate Education suggested to concentrate on Alumni to raise college fund, through CSR funds.

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Rev.Fr.Maria Louis, Educationist spoke about the curriculum framing and syllabus changing. He also told that teaching is a calling and every teacher trainee should be trained as 'Apostles'

Dr.Paul Devanesan suggested to add some topics under practicals in the following courses.

Promoting social behavior among students; Preventing social related school problem; Developing secularities among students; Risk factors responsible for religious based social atrocities and their preventive measures.

#### CPS 11 P - Pedagogy of Physical science Part-I

Practicals may be related to chemical changes and natural environmental safety.

Guidance and Counselling to develop consonance situation and create compromise behavior of teachers.

Unit:5 Adjustive behavior of students

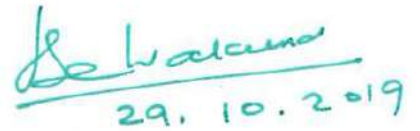
