Suggestions:

Prof. (Ms.) Suniti Sanwal [UGC Nominee] appreciated the inclusion of Artificial Intelligence for Teaching and Learning, ICT Enabled Education Courses into the revised regulations for the M.Ed. degree programme w.e.f. the academic year 2023-2024. She suggested the following areas,

- i) College should educate their teaching faculties about National Curriculum Framework (NCF) and its new approaches, new pedagogy in teacher education programme and form them as 2k teachers.
- ii) College could identify various changes that is taken place in school education regarding pedagogy, usage of technology and evaluation process and introduce these modified approaches to student teachers.
- iii) As per requirement of National Education Policy (NEP)-2020, the college could take initiatives for the introduction of integrated programme.

Dr. N. Vijayan, President, Meston Education and Development Association suggested that technology should be inculcated with pedagogy by giving regular orientation to staff. He also added that circulars given by the school education have to be collected and the new changes which are implemented there should be inculcated to the teachers and students for effective training. He emphasized that a committee could be formed to identify the changes in NEP-2020 related with school education and educate the teachers and students.

Rev. Fr. Lourdusamy Susai, spb, Secretary praised the efforts taken by the Principal, teaching faculties and non-teaching staff members during NAAC visit. He also added that our college should get higher grade in the next cycle of assessment. He suggested that meticulous planning, budgeting, hard working and proper monitoring could be done to improve the grading in NAAC.

At the end of the meeting, the Co-ordinator of the College Governing Board Dr. D. Arnold Robinson, Assistant Professor of Biological Science (SG) proposed the vote of thanks.
