182/2024 Plan of Action

The following Plan of Action has been proposed:

1. Meston Academy of Excellence – Improvise TET, CTET coaching and also provides study materials, conducting chapter-wise tests and mock tests.
2. Framing Internal Cell with Principal, senior most women faculty, student representative, advocate and an external member.
3. Collaborative Faculty Development Programme series with St. Ignatius College of Education, Palayamkottai, Tirunelveli.
4. Certificate courses in collaboration with other universities.

183/2024 Discussion

The Principal thanked the President of MEDA, Dr. N. Vijayan for the concession granted for the meritorious students and reported that so far 38 students had joined and updated about the admission status as on 19.07.2024. The President enquired about the e-content preparation which is under process and that will be implemented in the forthcoming year.

Dr. (Mrs.) D. Doreen Robin, Industrialist suggested to get feedback from student representative every month to evaluate the effectiveness of Teaching. She suggested to conduct two workshops per semester as students enhancement programmes. She also suggested that B.Ed. student-teachers can be encouraged to present papers in Seminars.

The President, Dr. N. Vijayan also seconded to encourage our students to present their papers in Seminars. President emphasized, to maintain a secured suggestion box, to receive feedback from the students, even without revealing their identity.

Rev. Fr. Lourdusamy Susai, SDB, Secretary, MEDA pointed out that as per his observation, the mentor mentee meet is being conducted to collect personal feedback and the same should be reported to the Principal.

Dr. N. Vijayan, President, MEDA is concerned about the failures and asked the faculty concerned to analyze the reason for failures. The report of the same should be sent to the President within a month. He also asked to conduct extra remedial classes to avoid failures in the future.

Dr. N. Vijayan, President, MEDA recommended Mr. Jebadoss Thinakaran, Headmaster of Madras Christian College Higher Secondary School, Chetpet, Chennai to be the external member of the Internal Complaints Cell and asked the Principal to list out the objectives of the Internal Complaint Cell. He also promised to nominate an advocate, as another external member for the Internal Complaints Cell.

Regarding the conduct of the Montessori training certificate course in collaboration with the other Universities, the President, Dr. N. Vijayan asked to frame the curriculum for the certificate course. Also he suggested that he would refer an expert for conducting Montessori training at free of cost. Further he encouraged the Principal to conduct more certificate courses during her tenure and make it remarkable in golden letters by organizing more Job oriented courses.

Dr. R. Asir Julius, Member - Alumni added to conduct a Workshop on "Rubrics with Technology" to assess perfectly in order to nullify bad assessment.
